WELCOME TO IMMANUEL GENIUS SUMMER PROGRAMS!

Summer is approaching and we understand the importance of making sure our students remain focused and motivated for the upcoming school year. The Immanuel Genius Summer Program is designed to engage students all summer long by making learning enjoyable and exciting!

- **We Play, We Learn**

Choosing the right preschool is important because it determines a child's first experience in a school environment. Immanuel Summer program is both welcoming and fun, while focusing on the fundamentals of preschool learning. Our 9 weeks program is divided into fun, motivating weekly themes including various hands-on experiences, high quality children's literature, creative arts, and physical development activities.

- **Small, Age-Assortative Class**

Summer programs are designed for 3 age groups: Toddlers (ages 2-3); Preschool (ages 3-4); Pre-kindergarten (ages 4-5). Class sizes of 10-16 students ensure each child gets individual attention and more differentiated curriculum based on children's interests and age-appropriate standards.

- **Engaged, Caring and Experienced faculty**

Classes will be led by professional early childhood teachers with dedicated and experienced staffs.

- **Special Enrichment Activities & Field Trips**

Everyday, Students will participate in various enrichment activities such as; Cooking, Show&Tell, Taekwondo, Music/Chapel and Ballet. Students will go on fun, educational field trips each week according to the weekly theme.
